ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO COMPETITIONS EFFFECTIVE FROM 1ST MAY 2014

The Rules of Golf as published by the R & A apply to all competitions at East Horton Golf Club.

On paying your entry fee and entering your name and handicap in the Competition Book you confirm that you are eligible to enter the competition # and agree to the conditions of entry, the details of which are set out below: -

#That your subscription is paid up to date and any upgrade charge and appropriate green fee has been paid.

#You hold a current active CONGU handicap.

#Golfers under the age of 18 must have their scorecard marked by an adult member of the Club who must not be a close relative.

#Golfers should make themselves aware of the Rules of Golf and how to proceed when doubt arises on the course (Rule 3-3). The Club's professional staff act as referees, any rules questions relevant to your score should be referred to them on your return to the Clubhouse before signing your card, their decision is final.

As regards to all Trophy/Honors board competitions competitors must have played in at least **3** previous qualifying competitions, this is to try and ensure the player's handicap is a fair reflection of their ability.

The Professional Shop administers the prize fund and divides it as it feels appropriate to the competition. Prizes will be in the form of Shop Vouchers or goods at the discretion of the Shop. Shop Vouchers must be presented for use in full within 180 days of issue, after this time they become void, there are no exceptions to this rule.

#The majority of competitions played take place between Friday and Monday, the first round played on the competition course during that period must be your competition round. On that **same** day when you have completed your card it must be placed in the box in the men's locker room.
