COURSE INFORMATION

The plan is for the Greenkeeping Team to commence necessary routine maintenance work on the greens from Monday 9th September. The plan is for the greens to be cored, seeded, top dressed and verti-cut. To perform this work we need to borrow the Blec Seeder from Carnoustie Links. The reason the work will take place before the season ends is there is still heat in the ground which will aid the recovery time, if we wait until mid-late October we have the issue of potential frost and lower temperatures meaning the greens would potentially not recover until the beginning of next season.

The main reason for the work is to improve the quality of the grass in the greens, aeration is key in maintaining healthy grass and ensuring we continue to have good quality putting surfaces. Aeration is needed when the soil beneath the surface becomes compacted, when the soil is compacted the grass roots struggle to breath.
