MORE HISTORY AS LIA IS CROWNED BEST OF THE BEST

There is only one place to start as we hand out plaudits for golfing achievements in the past week.

Lia Maxwell won the Fife Champion of Champions competition at Burntisland GHC on Sunday in extremely windy conditions to make history as the first Aberdour Lady golfer to win the regional accolade.

Eighteen club champions from Ladies sections all over the Kingdom took part and four players were tied at the close of play, however Lia won the silverware by two strokes on the better inward half.

Considering the quality of Lady golfers to play out of Aberdour over the years, it is an achievement of some magnitude for Lia to be the first from our club to win this event.

Despite a highly decorated golfing career, which has included twelve club championship titles as well as countless other victories, not to mention several years as a Category 1 player, this is undoubtedly the cherry on the cake for Lia.

Elsewhere in competitive action over the last seven days, **Pete Thow** won the Brett Trophy with 41 points on Saturday while **Maureen Richardson** took the spoils in the Ladies August Medal with a nett 38. The 3/4 Century Cup, for our "experienced" members was won by **Gavin Hughes** with 38 points.

Pat Macdonald won the May Walker Trophy on countback after signing for 33 points, while **Jack Small** won the latest round of Pennycook & Muir Medal in the junior section with a nett 70. **Willie Crowe** (nett 65) and **Lia Maxwell** (33 points) won their respective Wednesday Medals.
